## Competition Leadership – 2026

Oversees competition operations, race management, and event flow.

### Pat Petrie – Technical Director

Responsible for technical inspection, rule enforcement, and compliance across all divisions.

### Kevin Terrell – INEX Legends & Bandoleros Inspector

Oversees technical compliance for all INEX divisions.

## General Competitor Information (All Divisions)

### Pit Passes

#### Weekend Pit Pass

- Member Pricing: **\$80**
- Non-Member Pricing: **\$100**

#### Single-Day Pit Pass

- Member Pricing: **\$40**
- Non-Member Pricing: **\$50**

**Member Pricing applies to BOTH valid NASCAR members and valid INEX members.**

Membership must be current and presented when required.

---

## PitPay

PitPay will once again be utilized for the 2026 season.

- Racers and team members may pre-pay and pre-sign waivers through PitPay
- Use of PitPay allows competitors to expedite the check-in and credentialing process
- On-site check-in will still be available, but PitPay is strongly encouraged to reduce lines and delays

---

## Pit Spaces

- Full pit spaces available for purchase
- Cost: **\$800 per pit space**
- Limited availability; offered on a first-come, first-served basis
- Location, dimensions, and purchase procedures will be communicated separately

---

## Fuel & Tires

- **Sunoco Fuel** and **Hoosier Tires** will be available for purchase on-site throughout the 2026 season

---

## Licensing Requirements

**ALL Limited Late Model (LLM), Modified (MOD), Street Stock (SS), Factory Stock (FS), and Mini Stock (MS) drivers**

- Must possess a valid **NASCAR license**

**ALL INEX Legends and INEX Bandolero drivers**

- Must possess a valid **INEX license**

## Crew Members

- Strongly recommended to hold a **NASCAR and/or INEX license**

## Track Policies & Safety

- **NO BBQs or open flames** in pit areas
- **NO personal vehicles** permitted in the infield
- **NO golf carts, scooters, quads, or Motorized (Electric, Gas, Etc) Vehicles** allowed in pits or parking areas

## Minors in the Pits

- Permitted only with a completed minor release form and adult supervision

---

## Early Season Daytime Event Notice (January & February)

Competitors are advised that the January and February events will be run as daytime events. Teams should plan for **early pit gate access and earlier main event start times** compared to standard night schedules.

At this time, competitors should anticipate:

- **Pit Gates opening as early as 8:00 AM**
- **Main Events green flag at approximately 2:00 PM**

Final schedules, including exact pit gate, credentials, and on-track times, will be confirmed and published in each event's official registration packet. Teams are strongly encouraged to plan travel, staffing, and setup logistics in advance for these early-season daytime events.

This applies to:

- **January 24 – NASCAR Season Opener**
- **February 21 – Battle at the Bullring (CARS Tour West)**

### Friday Practice – Standard NASCAR Nights

- Practice Fee: NO ADDITIONAL PER CAR FEE FOR PRACTICE  
\*All Team Members must purchase Friday Pit Passes at Minimum\*

- Credentials Open: **4:00 PM – 8:00 PM**
- Pit Gate Open: **4:00 PM**
- Track Hot: **6:00 PM – 10:00 PM**
- All divisions may continue practicing until their respective main events are completed

### **Friday Night Main Events**

- INEX Bandoleros
- INEX Legends

Once Bandolero and Legend main events are complete, remaining track time will be dedicated to all other divisions.

- Practice Fee: **\$100 (RSVP by Emailing [info@lvmsbullring.com](mailto:info@lvmsbullring.com)) \$150 per car Day Of**
- Pit Gates Open: **8:00 AM**
- Track Hot: **10:00 AM – 4:00 PM**

Open to all divisions. Practice only. No points.

## Limited Late Models

### Championship Structure

Two championships will be awarded:

#### Bullring Track Championship

- Includes all **14 Limited Late Model events**
- Includes **both CARS Tour West events**

#### NASCAR Weekly Championship

- Includes **12 NASCAR-sanctioned Limited Late Model events only**
- CARS Tour West events **do NOT count**

#### Race-by-Race Purse

- 1st: **\$1,000**
- 2nd: **\$750**
- 3rd: **\$500**
- 4th–24th: **\$350**

## NASCAR Street Stocks / Factory Stocks

*(NEW STRUCTURE FOR 2026)*

Super Stocks and Outlaw Factory Stocks are combined into a single NASCAR-sanctioned division known as **NASCAR Street Stocks**.

### NASCAR Weekly Series

- Street Stocks and Factory Stocks compete together
- One NASCAR Weekly Series Track Championship

### Bullring Track Championships

- Track points kept separately for:
  - Street Stocks (formerly Super Stocks)

- Factory Stocks (formerly Outlaw Factory Stocks)
- Separate Track Champions awarded

## **Event Awards**

- Separate trophies awarded each race for:
  - Top Street Stock
  - Top Factory Stock
