



Prohibited Electric Personal Mobility Devices Policy

Las Vegas Motor Speedway

Las Vegas Motor Speedway prohibits the use of certain electric personal mobility devices on Las Vegas Motor Speedway property during all events and non-event operations unless expressly authorized by Las Vegas Motor Speedway.

This policy applies to all guests, staff, contractors, vendors, credentialed personnel, and third parties while on Las Vegas Motor Speedway property.

Prohibited electric devices include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Electric scooters
- Personal electric scooters
- Rental electric scooters not authorized by Las Vegas Motor Speedway
- Electric skateboards
- E skateboards
- One wheeled electric boards
- Self-balancing electric boards

These electric personal mobility devices are prohibited due to safety concerns related to pedestrian traffic, vehicle movements, emergency access, and crowd management at Las Vegas Motor Speedway. These devices are not permitted in parking lots, pedestrian walkways, concourses, service roads, restricted operational areas, or event venues located on Las Vegas Motor Speedway property.

Permitted mobility devices

All ADA compliant mobility devices are approved for use on Las Vegas Motor Speedway property and may be used in permitted guest areas and pedestrian routes when operated safely and without interfering with guests, emergency access, or event operations. Las Vegas Motor Speedway may restrict or redirect mobility device use in specific areas as needed for safety, crowd management, or emergency operations.

Enforcement

Las Vegas Motor Speedway reserves the right to deny entry, require the immediate removal of prohibited electric devices from Las Vegas Motor Speedway property, or revoke credentials for failure to comply with this policy. No storage or charging accommodations will be provided for prohibited electric devices.
